

chaam: unequaled comfort

no less than three patents filed to protect the design of the new alain mikli hinge (chaam) and define its characteristics.

characteristics and performances

- use of a buckle and a hook for the articulation of the temple.
- rotation axis clipped - so no risk that the temple unscrews.
- the drawing of the chaam was optimized in order to make the power of the spring exercise a constant pressure when the temples are in a position of opening, therefore the morphology of the wearer, the holding of the frame and the comfort are optimal.
- facility and dynamics of the opening of the temples.
- chaam opening over 40°
- adjustable closing mitre: one screw to adjust the closing of the temples, in order to avoid contact on the glasses (risk of scratching), contact between both temples when the frame is closed and to create perfection for the wearer. this screw facilitates a perfect fitting by the optician.
